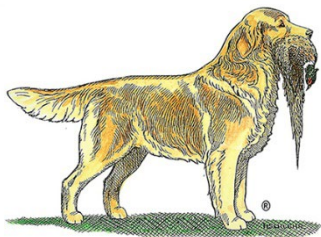

REFUNDS

Bitches in season are not allowed on the test grounds. Prior to closing, all scratches and refunds will be handled by Entry Express. To remove an entry before the close, handlers should go online to the event entered, go to the View Entries page and simply click on the "Remove" link shown beside the dog(s) entered and wish to remove, completing the information requested. A scratch fee will be assessed by Entry Express of any scratches handled by Entry Express.

Entry fees for a dog unable to compete due to being in season, illness, or injury, shall be refunded MINUS the Entry Express and AKC entry fee. To be eligible for a refund notification must be made to the Hunting Test Secretary before the start of the stake in which the dog is entered. Requests for all refunds must be submitted in writing, and in the case of illness or injury, accompanied by an appropriate veterinarian's certificate, and received by the Hunting Test Secretary no later than ten (10) days after the completion of the event. NO EXCEPTIONS!! NO refunds will be made on the event grounds. No refunds for no shows.

Running Order

The running order will be posted on Entry Express after the closing date. Whenever possible, dogs will be run in the order of the draw as fairly and expeditiously as possible at the discretion of the judges.

*****WAITING LIST POLICY*****

The GRCA will create a waiting list for the MH entries that are received after the test has been filled, but prior to the published closing date. If, after closing and up to the start of the MH test, there are entries known that will not be participating, dogs may be taken from the waiting list to run in the position of the absent dogs. ONLY dogs that are on the waiting list are eligible for the open positions (NO SUBSTITUTIONS). Dogs called from the waiting list shall be prioritized in the order the entries were received.

GRCA will contact the next person on the waiting list if known scratches occur after closing, and no later than 48 hours prior to the start of the test. You will have 12 hours to respond after being called to see if you want the next open position, or it will go to the next person in line and your name will be dropped to the bottom of the list.

THE MORNING OF THE TEST

If you are on the waiting list, and scratches occur between 48 hours before the test and the morning of the test, you must physically be present at the stake check-in 30 minutes prior to the listed start time of the test to be eligible for the open position. You will need to pay the GRCA with exact cash to the full amount of the listed entry fee plus the \$6.85 Entry Express fee for them to move you from the waitlist to the running order before the start of the test. *****Amateur Handler 35% Set Aside for Master Stake, Note:*****

Entries eligible for the amateur set aside must provide only one handler per dog and the handler must be an amateur.

*****Amateur Handler Limit*****

Entries reserved for amateurs shall open one day prior to general opening at 8PM in the time zone where the event is being held. If the amateur entry limit is reached in the 24 hours prior to the general opening, entries shall stop until the general opening. The maximum number of dogs an amateur can enter or run on the Amateur set aside process is 3 dogs per test. Any handler/owner misusing the amateur set aside provision will forfeit the ability to enter in this manner and may be subject to a fine from AKC.

All entrants and visitors to the site must have signed a Flatlander Kennel property owner waiver.
