TRIAL MAPS:

- Paper Gate sheets will be used for check in and running. Results will be physically posted.
- Maps will be available at www.BrinsonTrialServices.com the morning of the event.
- Posted map copies will also be available at the trial.

TRIAL SET UP/FACILITY HOURS:

- Set up starts at 7 am on Monday. We would greatly appreciate assistance.
- General site availability for all competitors is 7:00 am each day
- The site closes 30 minutes after judging ends.

TRIAL AND SITE REGULATIONS, AVAILABILITY & CRATING

- **Note:** Island Grove Park is an on leash facility.
- City of Greeley Ordinance - Dogs are not allowed in any city park except Island Grove Regional Park.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or in the designated warm-up area. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s), guest(s), and children.
- All dogs present must be held on a leash or confined to their crates or exercise pens, except when running.
- Handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions at and around their set-up area.
- NO dogs will be allowed in the restrooms.
- Do not leave dogs in closed vehicles. Dogs must not be tied to bushes, shrubs, trees or other permanent fixtures.
- GRCA reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate any way necessary. GRCA solely determines if said animal is in distress. All people attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club/s for such removal.

CRATING:

- Plenty of crating space is available, you may wish to bring shade covers if it is a warm day.

FOOD AND REFRESHMENTS AT THE TRIAL

- No Food Vendor will be onsite for this event. Several food establishments are close by.
- Filtered water is available in the arena. Please bring your own water bottle.

MOVE UPS AND CLASS CHANGES

From Chapter 1, Section 20: Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Move Up emails must be delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 5 PM on Monday, September 28, 2026.

Effective February 1, 2017

Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry. In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries, a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

GRCA TRIAL HOURS & SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Set up: 7am Monday

The trial site opens at 7:00 am. Judging starts at 8:00 AM. The site remains open until 30 minutes after conclusion of judging. Breaks may be called at the judge's discretion. Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received and wait listed entry changes not yet received. (**Judges reserve the right to reorganize the schedule below to accommodate the needs of the trial**) "B" class dogs will run prior to "A" class dogs in the Novice classes, within height classifications, except where otherwise indicated. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.
